Topic: Eastern Emergency Relief Network (EERN)

Christine, a member of RC Maroondah explained what EERN is and how it operates. They are a not for profit organisation who collect donated furniture and other household items and offers them free of charge through 140 member aid agencies. They have 2 trucks to collect goods. They "reside" in two factories in Thornton Cst Mitcham and are pretty unique in that they take mattresses and electrical goods. They do not deliver and the aid organisation customers must collect their goods within one week. They are the only such organisation in the Eastern suburbs and are 100% voluntary (no paid staff)
