Aaron highlighted there may be opportunities for Rotary to join them in some of their activities and some of their staff may like to become members of our Club.

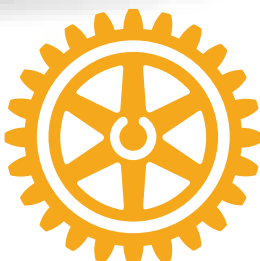
