CHOCOLATE BROWNIES

Heat oven to 350°F or 175°C

Grease bottom and sides of a 13" x 9" (33cm x 23cm) pan

Ingredients:

250g butter
¾ cup cocoa powder
2 cups sugar
1 ½ cups plain flour
1 ½ teaspoons baking powder
2 teaspoons vanilla flavouring
4 eggs

Method:

Melt the butter in a saucepan, add cocoa powder and stir until cocoa is well blended in.

Add – sugar, flour baking powder and vanilla and stir well.

Add the eggs and stir well.

Pour mixture into a prepared tin and bake for 25 – 35 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean from the centre.
