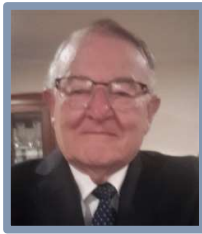

THE WEEK THAT WAS

Thursday 10th December, 2020

Guest speaker, Glen Tippet the Districts representative gave the Club an insight on the projects the Australian Rotary Health are providing funds for.

Australian Rotary Health is one of the largest independent funder of mental health research within Australia. Also providing funding for general health research, funding for scholarships for rural medical and nursing students as well as indigenous health scholars. Funding is focused into areas of health that do not readily attract funding.

Since the year 2000 the ARH has focused its funding on Mental Health Research and in 2013 focused on research projects in Prevention of Mental Health.

Funding allocations in 2020:

27 Research Project Grants	\$ 1.6 mill
9 PhD Scholarships	\$ 120 K
4 Post Doctoral Fellowships	\$ 277 K
53 Partner PhD Scholarships	\$ 642 K
1 Rural Medical Scholarship	\$ 5 K
7 Rural Nursing Scholarship	\$ 50 k
80 Indigenous Health Scholarships	\$ 400 K



Since the fund was established in 1981 by a Rotarian from the Mornington Rotary Club (Vic) \$47 Mill has been raised. Research into Sudden Infant Death Syndrome became its first research project. Today SIDS has been reduced by 80%.

Rotary Clubs are now able to nominate the area of research they wish their funds go towards. Our club's donation from Lift the Lid will be directed towards MMND research.
