

What a wonderful interesting presentation from our Guest Speaker at last week's meeting Elisa Gifford telling us about her job "Forensic Lab Testing"


We missed several of our members last week but good to know that Mike is home after his hospital visit and Fran and Brian have returned from Noumea.

Elisa explained in great detail the various areas of her work, from blood samples DNA checks Finger printing testing and disaster victim identification.


