Ferntree Gully Community Safety Grants

Foothills Community Care is among the recipients of Council grants to enhance safety in Ferntree Gully. Foothills received \$207,355 for an 18-month pilot program to improve experiences of safety and community connection in Ferntree Gully Village. Other recipients include Rotary Club of Ferntree Gully which received \$112,655 for the Knox Nocturnals Youth Group and Mountain District Learning Centre which received \$46,500 to provide activities and experiences for young people outside school hours and during holidays. A total of \$467,000 will be awarded under the Victorian Government's Empowering Communities initiative as part of the Building Safer Communities Program.
